Dave Wolf suggested to Robert that perhaps MLCA could take on the clean-up of the ditch that runs along Bayaud between Balsam and Brentwood west to the CCU property.

-> Jeslin has a meeting with Public Works soon and she will ask them about adopting this waterway.

-> Matt mentioned that Lakewood United Church of Christ has adopted 1st Ave and that perhaps MLCA could work together with the church on both clean-ups.

<u>City/CCU Follow-up</u>

Robert encouraged us to celebrate the victory achieved with the council vote on April 12 reinstating the definition of "student living unit" to the zoning ordinance. Matt reiterated comments he made in an email sent to the board the day after the vote (he's confident CCU will soon sue the city; agrees the zoning is unduly prejudicial to CCU; suggested MLCA reengage with both CCU and the city in the near future to maybe find some compromise).

Robert will make sure the definition is, in fact, reinstated in the zoning ordinance. <u>Annual Picnic</u>

It was decided to *not* hold the picnic this year due to the ongoing pandemic.
